NOTICE is hereby given to the Municipal Electors of the Township of Wellington North. Nominations in the Township of Wellington North for the Offices set out below may be made by completing and filing in the office of the Clerk of the municipality so noted, nominations on the prescribed form:

#### County Council

**County Councillor – Ward 3** 1 to be elected  
**County Councillor – Ward 4** 1 to be elected  
Nomination form to be filed with the Clerk, Township of North Wellington

#### School Boards

**Upper Grand District School Board:** 1 Member to be elected  
for Townships of Wellington North, Mapleton and Town of Minto  
Nomination form to be filed with the Clerk, Township of Wellington North

**Wellington Catholic District School Board:** 1 Trustee to be elected  
for Townships of Centre Wellington, Mapleton, Wellington North and Town of Minto  
Nomination form to be filed with the Clerk, Township of Centre Wellington

**Conseil Scolaire de District Catholique Centre-Sud:** 1 Trustee to be elected  
for Counties of Wellington and Dufferin, City of Brampton and Town of Caledon  
Nomination form to be filed with the Clerk, City of Brampton

**Conseil Scolaire de District du Centre-Sud-Ouest:** 1 Trustee to be elected  
for Counties of Wellington, Middlesex, Perth, Huron, Elgin and Region of Waterloo  
Nomination form to be filed with the Clerk, City of London

#### **Nomination Procedure:**

A nomination form **must be** signed by the candidate and filed in person by the candidate or his/her agent (faxes cannot be accepted) and filed during the hours of 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. between January 4, 2010 and Thursday, September 9, 2010) and on Friday, **September 10, 2010 (Nomination Day)** between 9:00 a.m. and **2:00 p.m.** only.

The onus is on the person nominated for election to an office to file a bona fide nomination paper.

A prescribed nomination filing fee of \$200.00 must accompany the nomination form for the Office of Mayor. A prescribed nomination filing fee of \$100.00 must accompany the nomination form for the office of Councillor or School Board Member/Trustee. All nomination fees must be payable by cash, debit, certified cheque or money order.

The fee is refundable if the candidate is acclaimed or receives more than 2% of the votes cast for the office or withdraws the nomination under Section 36 of the Municipal Elections Act, 1996, as amended.

A nomination must be certified by the Clerk before such person becomes a certified candidate for the office to which he or she is nominated.

In the event that there is an insufficient number of certified candidates to fill all positions available, nominations will be reopened for the vacant positions only, on **Wednesday, September 15, 2010**, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and **2:00 p.m.** and such additional nominations, if required, may be filed in the office of the Clerk as set out above.

Electors are hereby given notice that if a greater number of candidates are certified than are required to fill the said offices, voting places will be opened on dates to be determined for the purposes of voting.
