Walk the beautiful grounds and read the inscriptions on the headstones to get a fascinating glimpse of family history.

Research family members on our website to find out where they are interred in the cemetery and use the map to locate them.

There are about 50 burials a year. In 1907 there were 111 burials, 52 of which took place in November.

The chapel was built in 1947. Family and friends would gather for the services of loved ones. The unheated chapel fell out of use when funeral homes began holding services in their heated facilities.

The caskets are stored in the lower area of the chapel in winter months when burials are not possible.

The first columbarium was erected in 1999.

The scattering garden was added in 2018.
