GRANT RATE

Upgrading wells

80%, maximum of \$1,000 - \$2,000

Decommissioning unused wells

100%, maximum of \$1,500 - \$2,500

Please note all work must be done by a licensed well contractor. Farm applicants must have an Environmental Farm Plan.
