

DOMVILLE STREET (Arthur) NOTICE OF CONSTRUCTION AND ROAD CLOSURE

May 30, 2022

The Township of Wellington North's Contractor, Drexler Construction, has been busy preparing for the full reconstruction of Domville Street, between Preston Street and Conestoga Street, and new sidewalk between 150m west of Preston Street and Preston Street (see below key plan). Drexler expects construction to commence the week of June 6th, 2022 and will continue until the end of October 2022. Domville Street, within the identified limits, will be closed to through traffic during the construction period. Temporary closure of the intersections with Preston Street, Andrew Street and Conestoga Street will be required for short durations throughout the construction period and advance notice of the temporary closure will be advertised on the Township website. Local and emergency access will be maintained throughout construction; however, access to driveways will be interrupted at various times during this period.



Reconstruction will include full replacement of the watermain, sections of sanitary sewer, new storm sewer, roadway, sidewalk, driveway entrances, road asphalt and tree removals. New water, sanitary and storm services will also be installed to property line for residents on Domville Street. We would like to meet with you to discuss the location of the proposed storm service that will work best for your house. Properties with sump pumps will be required to connect to the new storm services as per standard drawing S2 (see back of this page). Township will reimburse homeowners up to \$250. Drexler Construction will be installing temporary watermain for water supply to your property during the construction period. The pipe proposed for this use will be installed on the existing ground with a pipe connected to your existing water service at property line. This temporary water system will be fully tested to meet Provincial and Municipal Standards before it is placed into operation. It will be monitored and tested regularly throughout the construction period.

Regarding garbage and recycling: On your designated waste and recycling collection days, please put your bags and recycling boxes at the standard roadside pick-up location by 7 a.m. Construction staff will pick them up and move them to a designated pick-up location as coordinated between Drexler Construction and the County of Wellington Solid Waste Services Division. Drexler Construction will return your recycling boxes to your property. Please ensure your recycling boxes are clearly marked with your civic address.


