Mayor Broomhead called the meeting to order.

Re:

THE LOCATION OF THE SUBJECT PROPERTY is in the Part Park Lots 7 & 8, Crown Survey, and has frontage on Preston Street (Arthur). The property is approximately 2 ha. (4.94 ac.) in size and vacant.

Owners:

Farz Holdings Inc.

THE PURPOSE AND EFFECT of the amendment is to amend the zoning of the subject lands in order to facilitate the development of lands for townhouses. The applicant is proposing to construct a 45 unit townhouse development that will eventually become freehold townhomes. This development will require relief from certain provisions within the cluster townhouse requirements including permission to have frontage on a private street. A reduction in the required parking will also be considered. Additional amendments dealing with the proposed development may be considered as required.

Please note – Section 34 (12) of the Planning Act.

(12) Information. – At a meeting under subsection (12), the council shall ensure that information is made available to the public regarding the power of the Municipal Board under subsection (14.1) to dismiss an appeal if an appellant has not provided the council with oral submissions at a public meeting or written submissions before a By-law is passed.

1. Notice for this public meeting was sent to the required agencies and published in the Arthur Enterprise News on November 21, 2008.

## 2. Presentations by:

 Linda Redmond Township Planner reviewed her correspondence dated December 12, 2008.

The Planning Department has no concerns with this application which would rezone the subject lands from R3(H) – Residential to R3-26(H) – Residential. This zone amendment would facilitate the development of a 45 unit townhouse project and eventual condominium application. The Planning Department is satisfied that the proposal is in general conformity with the County of Wellington Official Plan and the Wellington North Zoning By-law.

The proposal is to rezone the subject lands to allow a cluster townhouse development under the zoning provisions for street townhouse units. The applicants are proposing to construct a 45 unit townhouse development on a private road. The development will eventually form a plan of condominium in which the townhouse units will become freehold and the private road and common amenity areas will become common elements. Additionally a reduction in the required parking will be required as this development will require 68 spaces based on the requirement of 1.5 spaces per unit. The applicants are proposing to provide 55 spaces. A reduction in the required lot area per unit is required to accommodate the eventual condominium application.

The subject lands are currently zoned Residential-R3(H) which allows street townhouse, cluster townhouse and apartment dwellings. The draft by-law includes a site specific exception to address frontage on a private road, parking and lot area.

- 5. Mayor Broomhead opened the floor for any questions/comments.

Bruce Donaldson, the applicant's agent, was present to answer questions regarding this development. Stormwater management will be handled with an outlet that will go through land associated with the sewage treatment plant and then on to the river. His client intends to service the whole site and will be requesting allocation for 45 sewage units. The lots will be created through part lot control.

6. Comments/questions from Council.

Councillor Matusinec asked if the private road would be treated the same as the units in regards to maintenance. Mr. Donaldson informed Council that each owner will hold an interest in the road and amenity areas. Owners will own the unit and the patch of land around it.

Councillor Matusinec suggested that Mr. Donaldson provide a written request for the sewage allocation of 45 units.

Members present: Mayor Mike Broomhead, Southgate Councillor Dennis Evans, Dave Wenger, Doug McLellan, Ralph Winslade, Twyla Hunter, Councillor Ross Chaulk, Chairman Councillor Bob Mason and Linda Spahr, Recreation Co-Ordinator. Mark MacKenzie, Facility Manager arrived at 8:05 p.m.

Also present were: Carolann Morrison, co-ordinator of Mount Forest and Arthur pools; Derek Bridgewater, President of Mount Forest Minor Hockey and Clarence Sarvis, an interested citizen involving Minor Hockey.

New Member - Chairman Councillor Bob Mason welcomed Southgate Councillor Dennis Evans. He is replacing Deputy-Mayor Brian Milne.

Derek Bridgewater came to discuss hockey banners, the sponsor board and trophy cases. After considerable discussion it was decided that the sponsor board could hang underneath the two flags. Minor Hockey was given permission to hang up some pictures perhaps on the wall behind where the old flood machine was show cased. Twyla is going to contact other groups to see if they wanted to hang up pictures. Derek brought a quote he received for making trophy cases. The hockey banners are to be hung over the ice surface if it does not affect the lighting. Derek is to send a letter to council regarding the trophy cases. Linda explained that she had been contacted by Rebekah Broadfoot regarding the pictures of all the Queen of the Fair winners. Councillor Mason and Twyla will look after those pictures.

Linda asked Derek for the name of participants from West Grey that played hockey in Mount Forest. Derek said there has been a problem with Freedom of Information. ## **NEW BUSINESS:**

Carolann Morrison provided members with a written report on both pools and as well gave a verbal recap of the season. She was thanked by Councillor Ross Chaulk, Doug McLellan and Linda Spahr for her work.

Carolann did explain to members that there is a lot of extra cleaning hours at the Arthur Pool because of all the dirt in the playground blowing into the pool. Councillor Chaulk would like to see sod put in the budget to prevent this problem.

Mark MacKenzie stated he would like to see the high diving board removed in Mount Forest. The high diving boards are not considered safe at pools any more.

**Budget-year-to-date** - There was an error discovered by Mayor Broomhead earlier in the day with totals in the budget. Pages were replaced but discussion was left for another meeting.

Turf Maintenance Contract - It was decided to leave that information until the January meeting. Councillor Mason, Tom Bowden and Linda Spahr are to come up with a recommendation.

## CORRESPONDENCE:

SOCAN rules have been changed and this would mean a significant increase to renters. This is to be discussed at a SWORFA meeting tomorrow and groups will be sending out a generic motion for our local Councils to support re: changes to SOCAN tariffs. The change by SOCAN (March 2008) is to charge for room occupancy rather than the number of persons attending functions.

Facility Rentals - A spreadsheet was available for members to review the 2008 revenue from our facility rentals and compare them to 2007, 2006, 2005, 2004 and 2003. The total for 2008 as to October 31 is \$157,922.27 for Arthur and \$201,459.70 for Mount Forest.

Weskate - There was a request from Nicole West regarding the upcoming Weskate area competition. Because of the size of this competition Figure Skating is asking that the Walking Track be closed. They also have requested the netting be removed for the competition as it makes it

difficult for the judges and spectators to take photos. Figure Skating also wants to put a professional Skate Canada logo on a dressing room for club spirit and wondered if they could put it on dressing rooms 1 - 3. The following motion was approved:

The netting and logos will be discussed in January.

Complaint - A complaint was received from Reg Holinshead, Assistant Coach of Arthur Bantam Rep Hockey and the President of Arthur Minor Lacrosse. The complaint was regarding not being able to use a pool change room for hockey and having to hang up banners themselves instead of staff doing it. Linda explained she replied to Mr. Holinshead and also talked to Tom Bowden regarding this. Mr. Holinshead was asked to please contact Tom Bowden directly. Tom had explained to Linda that he keeps track of who uses what dressing rooms and if a team leaves the room a mess, they are refused entrance to that room for a few weeks to get the message across that these rooms must be kept in good condition. As far as hanging up the banners, Tom has stated that staff will gladly hang up banners but not until there are two staff people around for a safety precaution.

Update - Linda and Councillor Mason gave an update on work that Pastor Harry has been doing at the old arena by draining all the pipes. Drafting of a lease contract has been started.

Compliments – It is always good to hear positive comments. Linda received an e-mail from Steve Hardie, Recreation Director from North Perth. He had been at our new facility watching a game and wanted to let us know what a wonderful job was done on the arena. He said "everything seems to be very well laid out and user friendly." Doug McLellan stated that he had been all over the country giving out posters for the upcoming ladies hockey game and he too, received many compliments about our sports complex, even from Milverton who have an arena only five years old.

## **REPORTS:**

Arthur and Mount Forest Facility Manager's reports were available to members as well as the Recreation Co-Ordinator's report.

## MEMBER'S PRIVILEGE:

Mayor Broomhead - Wished everyone a Merry Christmas.

**Dennis Evans** - Thanked those who provided the lunch and wondered if we had that every meeting.

Doug McLellan - Has travelled all over the country putting up posters for our upcoming ladies hockey game. He was on the radio four times promoting our fundraiser. Other fundraising ideas are a skate-a-thon, video dance, gala event, concert and perhaps a relay for life.

Councillor Chaulk - Asked if letters were sent out to the various user groups inviting them to our meetings in the New Year. Linda advised members that the letters were sent.

Mark MacKenzie - Had numerous concerns: needed letters to go to Byes for snow removal, he wants the west side cleaned by 7 a.m. on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Saturday mornings. He would like to see the large snow pile pushed into the lot beside the parking lot. He repeated that there is to be no salt or sand under the canopy. Mark also said a letter needed to go to the Jr. C executive. There room needs to be kept clean. Linda has pictures to prove the mess it is in. Minor Hockey needs to be notified that teams are shooting pucks at the dressing room walls. They are defacing the building. The coaches should talk to the players. Mark will draft a policy for a Wall of Fame and bring it to our next meeting.

There are problems at the pool and it will be expensive to fix. Mayor Broomhead suggested that someone from the Lions Club sit on a committee to look at the problems at the pool. Linda will talk to Marty Young. Mark said there are problems with people coming over from the hall to watch the games and he would like to price gates for a fire exit but members can't get into the arena from the hall. The Health Inspector paid a visit and we cannot prepare food in the lower leisure hall unless we have a hand wash station. We also need handicapped parking signs outside.

Ralph Winslade - Asked where the ashtrays were that are to be outside. Mark is getting some made. Ralph invited everyone to the Holstein Santa Claus parade on Saturday as well as encouraged people to attend the Women's Hockey game in Mount Forest that night. He invited people to the Optimist New Year's Eve Dance in Holstein.

Twyla Hunter - Commented on how we need to straighten clocks and other articles hanging on the walls in Mount Forest and Arthur. She wished everyone a Merry Christmas.

Councillor Mason - Wished everyone a Merry Christmas.

Linda Spahr - Is looking into ordering signs that need to be put up at the entrances to Mount Forest telling people where the Sports Complex is located. Rich MacVicar sent some samples. The committee members just want the Sports Complex on the sign, not the Curling Club, or the Bowling Green. Linda is to order the signs but also check with Gary Matthews about installing them. Linda told members how happy she was with the usage of the walking track and reminded them there is a walk for memories coming up the end of January. Since October 17, we have brought in a total of \$1,188.92. Linda also announced that a cheque arrived at the office today for \$120,000.00 from the Complex Fundraising Committee. She complimented the committee for their hard work.

The Fire Department took part in the Mount Forest Santa Claus on December 5<sup>th</sup>.

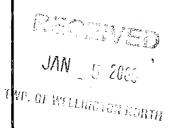

BEING A BY-LAW TO PROVIDE FOR AN INTERIM TAX LEVY ON ALL ASSESSMENT WITHIN SPECIFIC TAX CLASSES AND TO PROVIDE A PENALTY AND INTEREST RATE FOR CURRENT TAXES IN DEFAULT AND TAX ARREARS

AUTHORITY: Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, Chapter 25, as amended, Sections 317, 345, 346 and 347.

WHEREAS Section 317 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended, provides that the Council of a local municipality may, before the adoption of the estimates for the year pass a by-law levying amounts on the assessment of property in the local municipality rateable for local municipality includina pipeline. conservation lands. managed purposes. residential/farm. farmland, commercial. industrial and multi-residential assessments in the local municipality;

**AND WHEREAS** Section 317 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25, provides that the amount levied on a property shall not exceed 50 per cent of the total amount of taxes for municipal and school purposes levied on the property for the previous year.

**AND WHEREAS** Section 346 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended, provides that the Council may require the payment of taxes to be made into the office of the Treasurer by any day or days to be named herein, in bulk or by installments;

AND WHEREAS Section 345 of the Municipal Act, 2001 S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended, provides that the Council of a local municipality may impose late payment charges for the non-payment of taxes or any installment by the due date, a percentage charge, not to exceed 1 1/4 per cent of the amount of taxes due and unpaid, may be imposed as a penalty for the non-payment of taxes on the first day of default the non-payment of taxes in the manner specified in the by-law but interest may not start to accrue before the first day of default. and on the first day of each calendar month thereafter in which default continues, but not after the end of the year in which the taxes are levied;

**AND WHEREAS** Section 347 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended, provides that the Council of any municipality may authorize the Treasurer to accept part payment on account of taxes due and to give a receipt for such part payment, provided that acceptance of any such part payment does not affect the collection of any percentage charge imposed and collectable under Subsection (3) in respect of non-payment of any taxes or any class of taxes or of any installment thereof;

**AND WHEREAS** Section 345 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended, provides that the Council of a local municipality may require that the Treasurer, add to the amount of all taxes due and unpaid, interest at such rate not exceeding 15 per cent per annum as the Council determines, from the 31<sup>st</sup> day of December in the year in which the taxes were levied until the taxes are paid;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Wellington North (hereinafter called the Corporation) hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. **THAT** for the year 2009, 50 per cent of the total amount of taxes for the previous year shall be levied, raised and collected on all real property taxable within the pipeline, conservation lands, managed forest, residential/farm, farmland, commercial, industrial and multi-residential classes, and liable to pay the same according to the last revised assessment roll:
- 2. **THAT** the said interim tax levy shall be due and payable in two installments at the Township of Wellington North Municipal Office and most chartered banks and financial institutions as designated by the Municipality, on or before the following dates:

i. First Installment February 27, 2009ii. Second Installment April 24, 2009

- 3. THAT the Treasurer mail or cause same to be sent by first class mail to the residence or place of business of such person indicated on the last revised assessment roll, a written or printed notice specifying the amount of taxes payable, due dates and penalty and interest rates to be applied upon default.
- 4. **THAT** failure to receive the aforesaid notice in advance of the date for payment of the interim levy or any installment does not affect the timing of default or the date from which penalty shall be imposed.

- 5. **THAT** penalty of 1.25 per cent will be added to current taxes with installment due dates which are in default, in accordance with Section 2 of this By-law, as of the 1<sup>st</sup> day of March 2009 and the 1<sup>st</sup> day of May 2009 respectively to each installment due date, and thereafter a further penalty of 1.25 per cent will be added on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of each month and every month the default continues until December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2009.
- 6. **THAT** interest of 1.25 per cent on the amount of any taxes due and unpaid after December 31, 2009, shall be charged on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of each calendar month thereafter in which the default continues.
- 7. **THAT** the Treasurer be authorized to accept partial payment for taxes, from time to time, as long as it does not affect the collection of taxes registered for tax collection.
- 8. **THAT** the Treasurer be required to apply all payments received to the outstanding penalty and/or interest on the taxes that have been in arrears for the greatest period of time.
- 9. **THAT** the taxes shall be payable at par at the Corporation of the Township of Wellington North Municipal Office, or by mail to the Municipal mailing address, or through the telephone banking systems of most chartered banks and financial institutions, or over the counter at most chartered banks and financial institutions.
- 10. **THAT** this by-law shall be deemed to come into force and effect on January 1, 2009 and shall apply to all tax classes.
- 11. THAT in the event that any provision or section of this by-law is found by a court of competent jurisdiction to be ultra vires the posers of the Council of the Corporation, only such provision or section, as the case may be, shall be inoperative and all other provisions and sections of this by-law shall remain in full force and effect.

# THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WELLINGTON NORTH

# **BY-LAW NUMBER 2-09**

BEING A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE TEMPORARY BORROWING FROM TIME TO TIME TO MEET CURRENT EXPENDITURES DURING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2009.

AUTHORITY: Municipal Act, 2001, S.0. 2001, Chapter 25, as amended, Section 407.

WHEREAS the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001 Chapter 25, Section 407, provides authority for a council by by-law to authorize the head of council and the treasurer to borrow from time to time, by way of promissory note or banker's acceptance, such sums as the council considers necessary to meet, until taxes are collected and other revenues received, the current expenditures of the corporation for the year; and

WHEREAS the total amount which may be borrowed from all sources at any one time to meet the current expenditures of the Corporation, except with the approval of the Municipal board, is limited by Section 407 of the Municipal Act, 2001.

# NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WELLINGTON NORTH ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- The head of council and the treasurer are hereby authorized to borrow from time to time by way of promissory note or banker's acceptance during the year 2009 (hereinafter referred to as the current year) such sums as may be necessary to meet, until the taxes are collected and other revenues received, the current expenditures of the Corporation and the other amounts that are set out in subsection 407(1) of the Municipal Act, 2001.
- 2. The lender(s) from whom amounts may be borrowed under authority of this by-law shall be Royal Bank of Canada and such other lender(s) as may be determined from time to time by resolution of council.

- 3. The total amount which may be borrowed at any one time under this by-law, together with the total of any similar borrowings that have not been repaid, shall not exceed from January 1 to September 30 of the current year, 50 percent of the total and from October 1 to December 31 of the current year, 25 percent of the total of the estimated revenues of the Corporation as set forth in the estimates adopted for the current year or \$6,000,000.00 whichever is less.
- 4. The treasurer shall, at the time when any amount is borrowed under this by-law, ensure that the lender is or has been furnished with a certified copy of this by-law (a certified copy of the resolution mentioned in section 2 determining the lender,) if applicable, and a statement showing the nature and amount of the estimated revenues for the current year and also showing the total of any other amounts borrowed from any and all sources under authority of section 407 of the Municipal Act, 2001 that have not been repaid.
  - a) If the estimates for the current year have not been adopted at the time an amount is borrowed under this by-law, the limitation on total borrowing, as set out in section 3 of this by-law shall be calculated for the time being upon the estimated revenues of the Corporation as set forth in the estimates adopted for the next preceding year.
  - b) If the estimates for the current year have not been adopted at the time an amount is borrowed under this by-law, the statement furnished under section 4 shall show the nature and amount of the estimates revenues of the corporation as set forth in the estimates adopted for the current preceding year and the nature and amount of the revenues received for and on account of the current year.
- 5. All or any sums borrowed under this by-law shall, with interest thereon, be a charge upon the whole of the revenues of the Corporation for the current year and for any preceding years as and when such revenues are received; provided that such charge does not defeat or affect and is subject to any prior charge then subsisting in favour of any other lender.

- 6. The treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to apply in payment of all or any sums borrowed under this by-law together with interest thereon, all or any of the moneys hereafter collected or received, either on account of or realized in respect of the taxes levied for the current year and preceding years or from any other source, which may lawfully be applied for such purpose.
- 7. Promissory Notes or bankers acceptances made under section 1 shall be signed by the treasurer and the head of council or by such other person as is authorized by by-law to sign it.

# **BY-LAW NUMBER 3-09**

BEING A BY-LAW TO CONFIRM THE PROCEEDINGS OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WELLINGTON NORTH AT ITS REGULAR MEETING HELD ON JANUARY 12, 2009.

AUTHORITY: Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended, Sections 5(3) and 130.

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of The Corporation of the Township of Wellington North hereby **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:** 

- 1. That the action of the Council at its Regular Meeting held on January 12, 2009 in respect to each report, motion, resolution or other action passed and taken by the Council at its meeting, is hereby adopted, ratified and confirmed, as if each resolution or other action was adopted, ratified and confirmed by separate by-law.
- That the Mayor and the proper officers of the Township are hereby authorized and directed to do all things necessary to give effect to the said action, or to obtain approvals where required, and, except where otherwise provided, the Mayor and the Clerk are hereby directed to execute all documents necessary in that behalf and to affix the corporate seal of the Township to all such documents.
- 3. That this by-law, to the extent to which it provides authority for or constitutes the exercise by the Council of its power to proceed with, or to provide any money for, any undertaking work, project, scheme, act, matter or thing referred to in subsection 65 (1) of the Ontario Municipal Board Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter 0.28, shall not take effect until the approval of the Ontario Municipal Board with respect thereto, required under such subsection, has been obtained.
- 4. That any acquisition or purchase of land or of an interest in land pursuant to this by-law or pursuant to an option or agreement authorized by this by-law, is conditional on compliance with Environmental Assessment Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter E.18.
