The winning designs will then be printed (or recreated) onto board and mounted to one of three buildings in the municipality, the Kenilworth Municipal Office, the Arthur & Area Community Centre, or the Mount Forest & District Sports Complex.

- Hardcopy or electronic submissions are due by Friday, April 12, 2024, 4:00 p.m. and must be accompanied by a signed entry form.
- The cost of creating the board from the winning artwork and the installation will be covered by Wellington North.
- Must be original artwork of the person(s) named on the entry form
- The submission should reflect the positive aspects of amalgamation and/or Wellington North, reflecting our values, culture, and people. (Focus could be, but not limited to, local sports, landmarks, historically significant events/locations, or

natural beauty of Wellington North, with a focus on cooperation, collaboration, communication, shared culture, growth, progress, partnerships, and/or teamwork.

- Submissions will be judged by a panel of Township staff, Council, and Cultural Roundtable members.
- **Although we are seeking three (3) finalists, for three (3) separate pieces of art, The panel reserves the right to not make any (0) or fewer (1 or 2) selections for finalists.**
