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Fergus Street (Wellington St – Brimingham St), Mount Forest NOTICE OF CONSTRUCTION AND ROAD CLOSURE

April 29, 2024

The Township of Wellington North wishes to advise you of the reconstruction of Fergus Street between Wellington Street and Birmingham Street in Mount Forest (refer to key plan, below) will be taking place shortly. The Township of Wellington North's contractor, Kurtis Smith Excavating, plans to being full reconstruction of Fergus Street beginning as early as Tuesday April 30th, 2024 (see below key plan). Kurtis Smith Excavating expects to close this section of roadway beginning as early as Tuesday, April 30, 2024, and lasting until the end of June 2024. Local and emergency access will be maintained throughout construction; however, access to driveways will be interrupted at various times during this period. Effort will be given to advise residents of any disruption to access in advance. Some construction activities may continue to the end of July 2024. Reconstruction will include full replacement of watermain, various services from main to property line, roadway, sidewalk installation, driveway entrances and road asphalt. Properties with sump pumps will be required to connect to the new storm services as per the attached standard drawing S7. Township will reimburse homeowners up to \$250 upon submission of completed work and a paid contractor's invoice. Kurtis Smith Excavating will be installing temporary watermain for water supply to your property during the construction period. The pipe proposed for this use will be installed on the existing ground with a service pipe connected to an outside tap or connected to your existing water service at property line. This temporary water system will be fully tested to meet Provincial and Municipal Standards before it is placed into operation. It will be monitored and tested regularly throughout the construction period.


Regarding garbage and recycling: On your designated waste and recycling collection days, please put your bags and recycling boxes at the standard roadside pick-up location by 7 a.m. Construction staff will pick them up and move them to a designated pick-up location as coordinated between Kurtis Smith Excavating and the County of Wellington Solid Waste Services Division. Kurtis Smith Excavating return your recycling boxes to your property. Please ensure your recycling boxes are clearly marked with your civic address.
