**Smith Street (Highway 6), Arthur
NOTICE OF CONSTRUCTION AND ROAD CLOSURE**

April 22, 2024

The Township of Wellington North wishes to advise you of the reconstruction of Smith Street (Highway No. 6), between Conestoga Street and Wells Street, Arthur (refer to key plan, below). The Township has received funding for the project through the Ministry of Transportation (MTO) Connecting Links Program 2023-2024. Construction will be commencing the week of April 29th and will continue through to the end of August 2024. The Contractor for the project is Cox Construction Ltd. of Guelph, Ontario.



Smith Street, within the identified limits, will be reduced to one lane of two-way traffic during working periods (typically 7 am through 7pm, Monday through Friday) throughout the construction period. The roadway will be opened to two lanes of two-way traffic during non-working periods throughout the construction. Temporary closure of the intersections with Conestoga Street, Preston Street, and Wells Street may be required for short durations throughout the construction period and advance notice of the temporary closure will be advertised on the Township website. Local and emergency access will be maintained throughout construction; however, access to driveways will be interrupted at various times during this period.

Reconstruction will generally include full asphalt resurfacing, replacement of sections of boulevard, curb and sidewalk that are in poor condition, repair and restoration areas of deficient subgrade, replacement and/or installation of sanitary and water services at select locations, installation of accessible sidewalk ramps, pavement markings and construction of Pedestrian Crossover at the intersection of Smith Street and Conestoga Street. A Pedestrian Crossover will also be installed at the intersection of Main Street North (Highway No. 6) and Durham Street, Mount Forest as part of the construction contract. Regarding garbage and recycling: on your designated waste and recycling collection days, please put your bags and recycling boxes at the standard roadside pick-up location by 7 a.m. Construction staff will pick them up and move them to a designated pick-up location as coordinated between Cox Construction Ltd. and the County of Wellington Solid Waste Services Division. Cox Construction Ltd. will return your recycling boxes to your property. Please ensure your recycling boxes are clearly marked with your civic address.
