Traffic Calming Pilot Program

Subject: Traffic Calming Pilot Program – Resident Notification

Dear Resident/Neighbour/Homeowner,

In response to concerns about speeding on specific roads and throughout the Township, the Township of Wellington North wishes to advise you about an upcoming Council approved **Traffic Calming Pilot Program** that will be implemented in your neighbourhood as part of our ongoing efforts to augment road safety and enhancing the quality of life for residents. Speed and traffic data will be collected before installation and will be collected again afterward to evaluate the effectiveness of the traffic calming measures in reducing vehicle speeds in these areas.

Based on community feedback, recent traffic studies, staff report INF 2026-015 and Council endorsement, the below locations have been selected to participate in this temporary pilot program, which aims to reduce vehicle speeds, discourage cut-through traffic, and create a safer environment for pedestrians, cyclists, and drivers alike.

Program Details:

- Locations:
 - o Domville Street between Conestoga Street and Eliza Street
 - Church Street North between Sligo Road E and Wellington Street E
- Pilot Start Date: Spring 2026
- Duration: Spring, Summer and Fall 2026
- Traffic Calming Measures May Include:
 - Centre line flexible delineator



During the pilot period, we will monitor traffic patterns, gather resident feedback, and assess the effectiveness of the measures implemented. Your input is essential to the success of this program.
