### BACKGROUND

The request for tender (RFT) RFT 2026-001 for the Asphalt Program project was advertised on the Township website starting February 17, 2026, and closed on March 30, 2026.

### ANALYSIS

All tender submission packages were reviewed by staff based on the specified tendering requirements and evaluated on cost.

Associated Paving was the lowest tender bid cost, has completed previous capital asphalt contract project with the Township and meets the RFT requirements as specified. Therefore, Township staff recommend the award of this RFT to Associated Paving.
